_____ Length from thumb to little finger of outstretched hand.

_____ Length of Index Finger



Shoe Length

_____ Distance from heel to toe of shoe.



Foot Length

_____ Distance from heel to tip of big toe.



Height

_____ How tall you are.



Arm Reach

_____ Distance from floor to tip of upstretched arm.



Arm Length

_____ Distance from shoulder to tip of finger of outstretched arm.



Arm Span

_____ Distance from fingertip to fingertip of both outstretched arms.



Pace, Walking

_____ The length of your walking step.



Pace, Running

_____ The length of your running step.
